If you are building, renovating, extending your home or interested in learning how you can reduce your existing heating costs, please read on.

Have you considered solar panels for heating your hot water?

Connaught Solar is involved in the importation, distribution and installation of solar panels in the west of Ireland. We import our stock direct from the manufacturers in Greece/Italy/UK and China. All of our stock comes with full manufacturers warranty and has been tested in Europe by independent test centres. (TUV, SGS, ISO, CE)

If you have been living in your home pre June 2008 you would be eligible for a grant of €1471.00 towards the cost of buying and installing a 40 tube Blueclean solar system. Total cost of system €3300 (Inc VAT) MINUS €1471 = €1829 + fitting. (See quote attached)

The Grant for 40 tube systems supplied by other companies varies from €960.00 upwards.

Our Blueclean solar panels are one of the highest performing solar panels in Ireland and come with a 15 year warranty on the tubes and a 5 year warranty on the stainless steel frame. Our stainless steel water tanks also come with a 5 - 25 year warranty.

Blueclean solar panels are SEI registered and have the solar key-mark and are CE approved.

Connaught Solar provides a complete service to our customers, from supply only to a complete fitting and commissioning service. We also provide a partial fitting service where we will fit the solar collector on the roof and run the pipework to your hot press enabling your plumber to finish the installation.

Connaught Solar aims to provide each customer with a service second to none as we feel that this is the best advertisement for our company.

We provide 15m of stainless steel piping/10ltr Glycol/roof mounting kit/pipe fittings/air vent all at NO EXTRA COST with each system.

The SP116/SR962 solar controller that is supplied with each system comes in a tough durable steel box designed to withstand the test of time. It also has many features including a built in timer for immersion heaters if required. The majority of solar controllers on the market now only come in a polystyrene case which in time will disintegrate.

The stainless steel piping is supplied with 19mm thick insulation where as most other stainless steel piping comes with only 11mm thick insulation. This also helps to increase the overall performance of our solar systems.

If you are considering installing a solar system in your home Connaught Solar would recommend that you view a working system in a family home before you decide to buy. You are welcome to visit my home to inspect a solar system in operation. Connaught Solar is a family run business and is available 7 days a week to all of our customers.

Please note that if you are considering installing a solar system in the future you might need to install a domestic hot water tank now which incorporates a solar coil. If you are not sure please consult your plumber OR Connaught Solar.
